Other highlights of the night were Caroline Byrd's first place finish in the girls eight and under backstroke and Sophie Shelbourn's first place finish in the girls eight and under breast stroke. Jack Hosey won both the boys eight and under butterfly and breast stroke for the night.

Pine Forest had several of their young swimmers age up this year to the 9-10 age group where they are now required to swim 50 meters of the pool verses 25 meters for ages 8 and under. Those swimmer aging up who had a strong night were: Jordan Hooks in first place for breast stroke, Raymond Mennetti placed first in butterfly, Caroline Edwards swam for second place in breast stroke and Katie Stagliano swam backstroke for a second place finish.

Sisters Kelly and Katie Bosenberger had a wonderful night both taking first in butterfly and individual medley. Kelly also swam for a first place finish in breast stroke. Michael Tibbs and Brooke Bowen ruled the pool taking wins in all of the boys 13-14 events.

Samantha Hilleshiem shined as she won first in butterfly in the girls 9-10 age group as did Reeves Goette in breast stoke.
